Draw and cut out some fish from paper or card. Use the template below or draw your own.

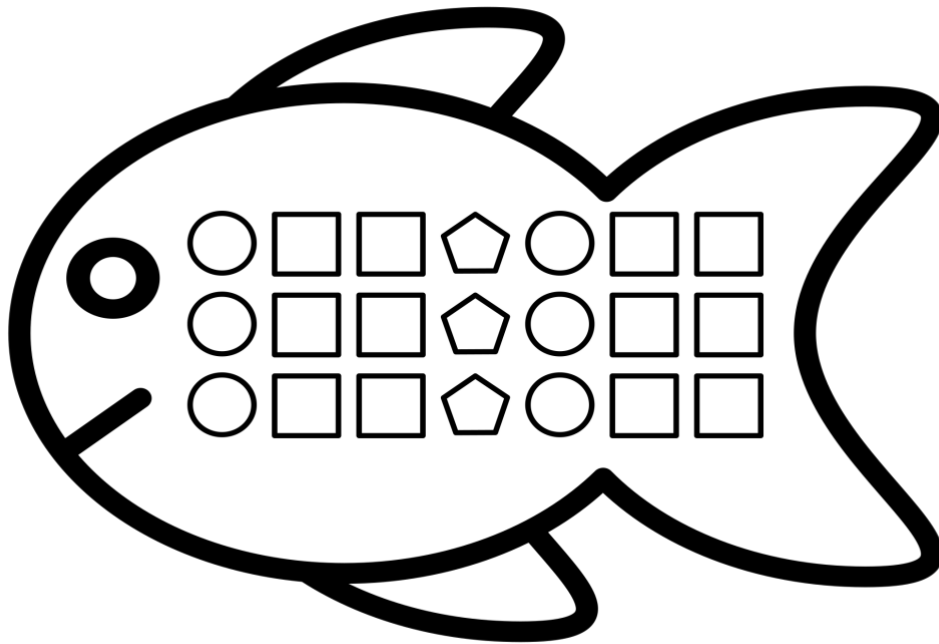
Attach a metal paper clip to the fish and check that it the fish is not too heavy for the magnet to lift. If it is, make your fish smaller or of lighter card or paper.
